GO BAG – SAMPLE Bag & ID **Emergency Radio/Batteries** Flashlight /Batteries All Purpose Tool Water Bottle (1 Gal. per person per pay) Water purification tablets Twine/Rope Duct Tape First Aid Kit (Standard) Solar Blanket Hand Warmers Candles Water Proof Matches Pad Paper/Pencils/Pens Medications - Prescription, non -prescription Meds i.e. pain, diarrhea, allergy, antacid, vitamins Work Gloves

GO FILE - SAMPLE

Emergency Family Plan - To include communications, pre-established routes, maps, meetings places and/or shelters. Be sure all family members are informed and kept up to date of changes. Be sure family member or trusted friend, out of the area, has the plan as well and is included in the emergency contact list.

ID – Drivers License; Passport; Birth Certificate Money; Credit Cards; Check Book – Banking information

Insurance Policies – Home; Health; Auto; Life; etc. with all agents' names & phone numbers

Wills; Advance Directives; Power of Attorney; etc. Health Records; Vaccination Records; Copies of prescriptions

Physicians Names and Phone Numbers Mortgage/Renters Info

Copy of your personal address, email & phone book data, computer file passwords

GO FOOD – SAMPLE

Non-perishable according to diet needs and restrictions

<u>REMEMBER – MAKE THE PLAN: GATHER YOUR</u> <u>SUPPLIES & PRACTICE TWICE A YEAR</u> <u>ALONG WITH ROTATING YOUR SUPPLIES</u>! THIS MAY ONE DAY SAVE YOUR FAMILIES LIFE ~ Disposable Gloves Toilet Paper/ Tissues Tarp Whistle Flares Hand Sanitizer Sunscreen Garbage Bags & Baggies

Children's Supplies/ Senior's Supplies/ Person's with Disabilities Supplies (All age & function appropriate) Ex: Coloring books; baby food & diapers Medications; mobility issues

Pet Supplies – appropriate to your pet i.e. leashes; food; meds; cat litter; Vet records; etc.

GO CLOTHES/BEDDING - SAMPLE

Weather appropriate for area and time of year – This will force you to look at your supplies at least once a year!! Warm weather and Cold weather and also rotate, practice and update your plans and information! i.e. Rain gear vs. Snow gear !!
