Edgemont Ranch Metropolitan District Meeting of the Board of Directors Minutes

The regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Edgemont Ranch Metropolitan District was called to order at the District office on Thursday, December 5, 2019 at 4:26 PM.

Directors in attendance were: Al Winzerling and Steve Martin. Andrew Rapiejko arrived about 4:26 PM. Larry and Rich had excused absences. Metro staff members in attendance were: Mark Fuson, Kurtis Martinez, Robert Ludwig and Mike Lancianese, Marilyn Heide and Annette Hutchins. In attendance were: Tom Gorton and Kelli Stanley.

Mr. Martinez gave a brief update on the progress of the Waste Water Treatment Plant. Metro was still waiting on the state for a response to the plans. In the meantime the District is continuing the same schedule.

Staff members, Robert, Kurtis, Mark and Mike were excused from the board meeting early.

Mr. Winzerling moved to approve the Regular Metro Board meeting minutes from October 17, 2019, seconded by Mr. Rapiejko, and was carried unanimously.

Marilyn reviewed Metro's Proposed Budget for 2020. In an effort to increase the General Fund Reserve for re-surfacing roads, many of the administrative, personnel and vehicle & equipment expenses have been reallocated between funds to 20% General, 40% Water and 40% Sewer. The previous allocations initiated in 2011 were either an even split or 35% General, 30% Water, and 35% Sewer. The new allocation also more accurately reflects the actual expense to each fund. Mr. Martin moved to approve the Resolution to Adopt Budget for 2020 (#2019-12-5.1), seconded by Mr. Winzerling and was unanimously approved. (See attachment)

Mr. Martin moved to approve the Resolution to Appropriate Sums of Money for 2020 (#2019-12-5.2) and the Resolution to Set Mill Levies for 2020 (#2019-12-5.3), seconded by Mr. Rapiejko and was unanimously approved. (See attachments)

Mr. Martin moved to accept the Metro Board Dates for 2020, February 20, April 18, June 18, August 20, October 15, and December 3, seconded by Mr. Winzerling and was unanimously approved. (See attachment)

Mr. Winzerling moved to accept Resolution #2019-12-5.5: Listing five Edgemont Designated Posting Locations of ERMD Meeting Notices for 2020, seconded by Mr. Rapiejko and was unanimously approved. (See attachment).

Mr. Martin moved to keep the Metro Board officers the same for 2020, unless there was a change later in the year, seconded by Mr. Winzerling and was unanimously approved. Steve Martin – President, Larry Mongelli – VP, Rich Butler – Sec/Tres, Al Winzerling and Andrew Rapiejko – Directors.

Lastly, Mr. Martin reported on Board concerns. There was a resolution, #2019-12-5.4, appointing a designated election official and authorizing the designated election official to cancel the election. Mr. Martin moved to appoint Marilyn as the designated election official for the regular special district election scheduled for May 5, 2020, seconded by Mr. Winzerling and was unanimously approved. Mr. Martin moved to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Winzerling.

The Board then adjourned into executive session for the purposes of personnel evaluation and compensation pursuant to Sec, 24-6-402 (4)(f), C.R.S. at 4:38 PM.

The Board re-convened the public meeting about 5:10 PM. After reconvening the public meeting, the Board unanimously approved the report of the Compensation Committee which will govern the balance of 2019 and the commencement of 2020. Thereafter the meeting was adjourned.

RESOLUTION TO SET MILL LEVIES

A RESOLUTION LEVYING GENERAL PROPERTY TAXES FOR THE YEAR 2019, TO HELP DEFRAY THE COSTS OF GOVERNMENT FOR THE EDGEMONT RANCH METROPOLITAN DISTRICT, COLORADO, FOR THE 2020 BUDGET YEAR.

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Edgemont Ranch Metropolitan District, has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on December 5, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating purposes from property tax revenue is \$235,539; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for bonds and interest is \$62,908; and

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for taxes abated and refunded as of August 1, 2019 is \$30; and

WHEREAS, the 2019 valuation for assessment for the Edgemont Ranch Metropolitan District as certified by the County Assessor is \$29,913,550.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE EDGEMONT RANCH METROPOLITAN DISTRICT, COLORADO:

That for the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Edgemont Ranch Metropolitan District during the 2020 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 7.874 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2019.

That for the purpose of meeting all bonds and interest of the Edgemont Ranch Metropolitan District during the 2020 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 2.103 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2019.

That for the purpose of meeting the taxes abated and refunded as of August 1, 2019, the Edgemont Ranch Metropolitan District during the 2020 budget year there is hereby levied a tax of 0.001 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the District for the year 2019.

That the Controller is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of La Plata County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Edgemont Ranch Metropolitan District as hereinabove determined and set.

RESOLUTION APPOINTING A DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL AND AUTHORIZING DESIGNATED ELECTION OFFICIAL TO CANCEL ELECTION

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32-1-804(2), 1-13.5-513, 1-11-103(3) C.R.S.

WHEREAS, pursuant to 32-1-804(2), C.R.S., the Board of Directors of the <u>Edgemont Ranch Metropolitan District, La Plata</u> County, Colorado is authorized to designate a Designated Election Official (the "DEO") to exercise the authority of the Board in conducting the election, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 1-13.5-513, C.R.S., the Board can authorize the DEO to cancel the election upon certain conditions;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Directors of the Edgemont Ranch <u>Metropolitan District, La Plata</u> County, Colorado that:

- The Board hereby names [has named] <u>Marilyn Heide</u> as the DEO for the regular special district election scheduled for the 5<u>th</u> day of May, 2020.
- 2. The Board hereby authorizes and directs the DEO, if the only matter before the electors is the election of persons to office, to cancel said election and declare the candidates elected, if at the close of business on the sixty-third day before the election there are not more candidates than offices to be filled, including candidates filing affidavits of intent to run as write-in candidates.
- 3. The Board further authorizes and directs the DEO to publish and post a Notice of Cancellation of election in the offices of the DEO, the county clerk and Recorder of each county in which the district is located. The DEO shall also notify the candidates that the election was cancelled and they are elected by acclamation.

4. Pursuant to §1-11-103(3), and §1-13.5-513(1)&(4), if the DEO has cancelled the election, the DEO or district will file this resolution, together with the Notice of Cancellation, with the Division of Local Government.
